MATERIALS: Entrenched outline, raised floor space, collapsed granodiorite chimney.

KNOWN BACKGROUND: Valued at £15 in original survey and attributed to Patrick McLaughlin.

COMMENTS: Hut is on a low flat area threatened by run-off from high ground to the south, soil is piled on the south-west and north-west sides. Chimney is very small, occupying only one third of end wall. Site is vestigial.
