


KNOWN BACKGROUND:

COMMENTS: Site is a very large split rock in a natural clearing with numerous springs. Bogong moths were found in the cave, which has been disturbed by wombats. The site commands a view of much of the Orroral Valley and is on the most practicable route from the SKETCH: valley to the Honeysuckle Creek area.
